Happy New Year!

This New Year's Day Mary and I sat down, as we frequently do around



January 1, to review our charitable giving and to make decisions for the new year. It allows us to consider and confirm (or to make changes) in those areas we want to support.

Why am I telling you this? For two reasons.

First, I recommend this practice to you.

You are able to make pro-active decisions without the pressure of fundraising calls. You may choose to give a greater amount to the charities you really want to support rather than giving a small amount to, possibly, assuage a bit of guilt.

Second, we have decided to increase our giving to St Alban's by 10% and I invite you to increase your giving to St Alban's by 10%. If you are giving \$20 per week, increase by \$2. If you are giving \$50 per week, increase by \$5. The math is easy.

We all have been so blessed by God and this faithful community of St Alban's. This is one way to say "Thank You."
